

## **2008 CCMI Hat Trick Rules**

- **Catch & Release only** – Kept fish are not eligible for this contest.
- **Three Muskies caught and released at or above 30”**. One each from three of the following five lakes: Lake Kegonsa, Lake Mendota, Lake Monona, Lake Waubesa, or Lake Wingra.
- **Duration** – Entire Calendar Year fishing season - must be caught and released legally complying with all WDNR and Muskies, Inc. regulations.
- **Reporting**: Reporting to Release Chairman upon submission in registering fish you must indicate the exact lake, lure, date, time and size. (e.g., you would be ineligible if you indicated “Madison Chain” on registration when identifying where the fish was caught).
- **Maximum of one CCMI Hat Trick award per year, per qualifying member.**
- **Member agrees to allow the use of the photo(s) for CCMI poster boards, newsletters, brochures, presentations, literature, etc.**
- **Must be a CCMI member in good standing at time of Muskie catch & release, registration, request for award and issuance of the CCMI Hat Trick Award.**
- **Form**: The CCMI Hat Trick Award form is available on line at [www.capitalcitymuskiesinc.org](http://www.capitalcitymuskiesinc.org) or must be specifically requested from the Release Chairman (Note: it will not be automatically sent, the CCMI member must keep track and specifically request the form). Request must be submitted to the release chairman only after the three qualifying Muskies are caught/released and registered (either on-line or by release form).
- **A photo of each fish is required and must be submitted at time of completion of Hat Trick form. A witness is not required**
- **Awards:**
  - **Recognition at annual awards banquet**
  - **If approved by the CCMI Board – potentially a patch or a pin may be awarded**
