CCMI Outing Champion Emblem

A new award was approved by the Capital City Muskies Inc. Board of Directors on 11/05/2018. Those members of Capital City Muskies Inc. who win First Place (Champion) in an approved CCMI Outing will receive a cloth emblem-patch. This emblem is in addition to any other plaques, trophies etc. that are approved by the Outing Coordinator.

Currently CCMI as six approved Outings annually. They are as follows:

Iowa Hawg Hunt, Madison Chain Outing, Bill Wood Lake Winter Outing, PIT Tag Challenge, Lake of the Woods Outing and the Vilas County Outing.

- 1.) The Champion of an Outing must be a member of Capital City Muskies Inc. to receive the emblem. However, if the Non Member Champion becomes a member of CCMI within one year of the win that person will receive the award at the request of the winner.
- 2.) The Champion of an Outing must catch a muskie 30 inches or longer during that particular event to receive the emblem. Regardless of an Outing rule or decision, the Champion cannot receive an emblem unless the angler catches said 30 inch or longer muskie during that calendar year outing.
- 3.) The Outing Coordinator or designee will present the emblem to the Champion at the time of the Awards Presentation.
- 4.) Due to the fact that this is a new award and 50 emblems are required as a minimum purchase order, past winners of a CCMI Outing may receive an emblem retroactively. If a question arises as to eligibility of a past Outing winner the Outing Coordinator or designated CCMI Board member will investigate and review past CCMI Newsletters for a determination of eligibility.
- 5.) The emblem-patch will be cloth, oval in shape and approximately 5 inches by 4 inches in size. The emblem will contain the CCMI Logo and a gold star located at the bottom of the emblem. An addition gold cloth star, iron heated, can be requested by the winner for each Outing that the angler has won in the past.
