Muskies in July: A Fishing Forecast and New Insights

Hello, CCMI members! As we step into July, it's time for an update on the weather outlook, top bait choices, and some fascinating research insights on our favorite fish - the Muskie.

July Weather Outlook

July promises an exciting mix of weather conditions. Here's what you can expect:

- Jul 1-7: A few thunderstorms with cooler temperatures up north and hot down south.
- Jul 8-15: Scattered thunderstorms and hot temperatures.
- Jul 16-26: Isolated thunderstorms with warm weather.
- Jul 27-31: Sunny up north, a few thunderstorms down south, and cooler overall.

The average temperature for July will be around 77°F, which is 1° below average, and we can expect precipitation of 5" (1" above average).

Preferred Bait and Conditions

Summer brings on my favorite bite, and when it comes to bait, bucktails and blades, particularly black ones, are highly recommended. Tubes are also a popular choice for summer fishing. Stagger blades are gaining popularity, too, due to their effectiveness.

Muskie Diets: Unveiling the Mystery

Very cool research is being conducted on Muskie diets. I have been following Kamden Glade from the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, and he and his team have been investigating what Muskies really eat and how their introduction to new lakes could affect the ecosystem of other trophy fish.

Key findings of Kamden's research are:

- Muskies primarily prefer Yellow Perch, especially in deeper, clear lakes.
- Crappies and Sunfish are more prevalent in their diet in shallower, densely vegetated lakes.
- Despite their spines, Bullheads were also found in Muskie diets.
- Cisco, though rarer in the diet in some lakes, played a significant role in others.
- Muskies have a special love for suckers, thanks to their lack of spines.
- Vertebrates such as frogs, muskrats, and even occasional birds were found in the Muskie diet.

The study further showed that Northern Pike and Walleye diets were similar, irrespective of the season or Muskellunge presence. Also, Yellow Perch numbers were linked with Walleye diets, indicating overlapping prey preferences. The key takeaway is that while Muskellunge, Northern Pike, Walleye, and Largemouth Bass can coexist in different lakes, it's crucial to assess the availability of key prey and habitat features before implementing management decisions like fish stocking. Such proactive steps can help ensure sufficient prey availability and avoid escalating competition among these predators, thereby protecting existing fish populations. I'll keep sharing more insights from this research throughout the year. Let me know if you want a link to the complete study. Kamden also has a great webinar I can send a link to.

Here is to a successful July. Keep your hooks sharp, and we will see you on the water.

Vilas County Outing: October 13th and 14th, 2023

The annual Vilas County Muskie 2-day Outing will be held Friday, October 13th and Saturday, October 14th, 2023. This is a friendly outing for CCMI members, family and friends. You do not have to be a CCMI member to participate.

All participants must submit a waiver of liability form in order to participate in the outing. Please print out the waiver of liability form at the CCMI website and submit it to Dale Anderson with your outing and/or banquet fee payment. The outing banquet will be held at the Rustic Roadhous, located at 5194 S, US Hwy 51, Manitowish Waters. The Rustic Roadhaus will be closed to the public and our banquet will be a PRIVATE event this year. There will be "fish stories" at the bar (cash bar) at 5:30 p.m. with dinner served around 7:00 p.m. Awards, Door Prizes and Raffles after the dinner. Folks may attend the dinner and not participate in the outing. The dinner will be a choice of 3 entrees:

CONTEST RULES:

Muskies caught from 7:00 a.m. Friday, October 13th, to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 14th, will be eligible for awards! There is no sign in. Report all muskies caught by 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 14th, to **Dale Anderson** at the Rustic Roadhaus. To be eligible for an award, a witness is required (an outing participant for all entries) **AND your outing fee** must be received prior to the start of the outing (prior to October 13th). Photographs of fish caught are requested (Digital or Polaroid). This is a Catch and Release contest only! Artificial baits and Quick Set sucker rigs are allowed – no swallow hooks for suckers!

Participants must comply with all WDNR regulations. <u>Gas motor trolling is allowed during this outing.</u> Only muskies that are 30 inches or longer are eligible for an award, except for the "smallest" muskie category! Measure fish to the quarter-inch to help in a tie-breaker situation. In the case of a tie the first fish caught will be the winner. Eligible waters are any body of water located within Vilas County, Wisconsin.

Winners may only win in one category! Walnut Plaques will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place:

- 1) Largest muskie by length in inches
- 2) Second largest muskie by length in inches
- 3) Third largest muskie by length in inches
- 4) Smallest muskie by length in inches-gets a Muskie Base trophy

Drawings will be held for door prizes for outing participants. Folks who attend the banquet but do not participate in the outing are not eligible for door prizes.
