

Reproduction Contest Reminder

Submitting your entry for the reproduction contest just got easier. A web form was created to allow you to enter your details and picture and send it right to the release chair. You can get to the web form from the CCMI member contest page or using this link: CCMI Replica Contest Entry Form - Capital City Muskies Inc

Just as a reminder, the reproduction contest is for any muskie caught 45" or longer is eligible to be entered in the reproduction contest. Along with being entered in the Lunge Log within 30 days of the catch, a picture of the fish (or a witness statement) must be submitted to the Release Coordinator. The chapter awards payment for an artistic reproduction (graphite replicas, custom paintings, etc.) for one fish caught in Wisconsin and one fish caught outside of Wisconsin.

Madison Musky Stocking Update

At the November 13, 2023 CCMI general meeting, the board presented, "2023 Musky Crisis on the Madison Chain." We shared the history of muskie stocking on the Madison chain, CCMI's involvement in that stocking, and the recent lack of musky stocking by the Wisconsin DNR (WDNR). Typically, the Madison lakes have received the following number of fingerlings annually: 1,647 in Monona, 1,000 in Waubesa, and 100 in Wingra. In 2020, 2022, and 2023 the WDNR failed to stock any musky fingerlings from the WDNR hatcheries into our Madison lakes. In 2023 alone CCMI invested \$30,100 to stock 1,921 musky fingerlings into Lake Monona. Our chapter expanded our efforts to stock additional musky fingerlings when the WDNR could not, and we are now looking to what may be needed in the future.
