DANE COUNTY STOCKING UPDATE!!!!

On Thursday, September 18, there were 2,314 musky fingerlings stocked into Lakes Wingra, Monona, and Waubesa by CCMI and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR). Despite Muskellunge being our Wisconsin state game fish, muskies do not reproduce naturally in sufficient quantities to support a fishable population in southern Wisconsin. This joint effort between CCMI and the WDNR has been going on since the 1980s. The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has recently changed to only stocking Great Lake Strain musky fingerlings in even numbered years due to budgetary reasons. In 2024 over 2,800 WDNR Great Lake Strain musky fingerlings raised at the WDNR Wild Rose Hatchery and sourced from the Fox River near Green Bay were stocked into lakes Wingra, Monona, and Waubesa at no cost to CCMI. This year's fingerlings averaged a VERY healthy 12 inches. These 2,314 musky fingerlings come from Gollon Bait and Fish Farm in Dodgeville, WI are classified as Wisconsin Strain. They cost CCMI \$32,396 to purchase this year (\$14 each). These fingerling muskies are the result of manually mixing musky eggs and musky milt for fertilization in the spring of 2025. The number of muskies stocked for each lake must follow a WDNR formula/regulation involving lake size and existing musky population for optimum musky population management.

Stocking distribution in the three local lakes went as follows:

- Lake Wingra received 100 musky fingerlings
- Lake Monona received 1,177 musky fingerlings
- Lake Waubesa received 1,037 musky fingerlings

Lakes Mendota and Kegonsa do not receive stocked muskies since they are not managed by the WDNR as musky fisheries. Another CCMI/WDNR musky stocking event is planned for Lake Monona Olin Boat Launch at about 8:30 AM Thursday October 23, 2025. This additional musky stocking event of 500 musky fingerlings Leech Lake Strain is done for improved biodiversity and to continue potential joint WDNR/CCMI research data about survival and growth potential of this strain in the Madsion Chain. Volunteers, nonmembers of CCMI, and donations are welcome at our stocking events and free monthly meetings. CCMI is tax exempt IRS 501(c)(3) charitable organization. The economic impact to the Madison area from musky fishing is significant.

The outing banquet will be held at the Rustic Roadhaus, located at 5194 S, US Hwy 51, Manitowish Waters. There will be "fish stories" at the bar (cash bar) at 5:30 p.m. with dinner served around 7:00 p.m. Awards, Door Prizes and Raffles after the dinner. - There is no sign in.

- Report all muskies caught by 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, October 11th, to Dale Anderson at the Rustic Roadhaus.
- To be eligible for an award, a witness is required (an outing participant for all entries) AND your outing fee must be received prior to the start of the outing (prior to October 10th).
- Photographs of fish caught are requested (Digital or Polaroid).
- This is a Catch and Release contest only! Artificial baits and Quick Set sucker rigs are allowed no swallow hooks for suckers!
- Participants must comply with all WDNR regulations.
- Gas motor trolling is allowed during this outing.
- Only muskies that are 30 inches or longer are eligible for an award, except for the "smallest" muskie category! Measure fish to the quarter-inch to help in a tie-breaker situation.
- Eligible waters are any body of water located within Vilas County, Wisconsin.

Winners may only win in one category! Walnut Plaques will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place:

- Largest muskie by length in inches
- Second largest muskie by length in inches
- Third largest muskie by length in inches
- Smallest muskie by length in inches-gets a Muskie Base trophy






